



## XXII INTERNATIONAL JULIUSZ ZARĘBSKI MUSIC COMPETITION ŁOMIANKI ~ WARSAW 2022

*Our unchanging competitions concept remains to create a musical venue where students, teachers, and musicians, both practitioners and theoreticians, can meet. A forum geared to the exchange of thoughts, views and experiences on children performing music. At the same time our competition does not aspire to 'set or break any records'. Our aim is to promote the love of music for its own sake, in a peaceful and relaxed atmosphere. The whole concept of the competition is geared to giving each and every young musician stage experience. It is also for this reason that we prefer applicants from small, out of the way, often provincial centres. Though we remain committed to seeking and promoting outstanding talent, we would like young artists to treat participation in the competition as a prize in itself. Something that motivates each and every one of them to greater effort and achievement, on the road to finding their own place in the world of music.*

### RULES OF REGULATIONS ON LINE.

#### 1. BASIC INFORMATION

##### 1.1 Organisers:

The Juliusz Zarębski Cultural & Education Foundation;  
Łomianki Music School based in the town of Łomianki.

#### 2. COMPETITION OUTLINE

##### 2.1 Competition sections:

- 1) Piano solo;
- 2) Chamber Ensemble;
- 4) Soloists: violon and cello (possible participation of a professional pianist accompanist without age limit).

##### 2.2 Competition Category:

- A – born in 2013 and younger
- B - born in 2010 and younger
- C - born in 2008 and younger
- D – born in 2006 and younger
- E - born in 2003 and younger
- F - no limit

2.3 The **Competition Auditions** are conducted in the mode of audio video recordings. The recording mode and conditions can be found in the INSTRUCTION at [www.konkurs-zarebski.eu](http://www.konkurs-zarebski.eu).

2.4 All property rights to the said performances are deemed by all participants to belong to the competition organiser, and pass to the said organiser free of any charge. The organiser reserves the right to photograph, record, and distribute performances as well as make use of the works performed, without time, territorial or any other limits. Including rights to: (a) transcription, by any technique and without copy limits; (b) Trade; (c) Public performance, reproduction, and distribution in the form of compacts discs, video and cassette recordings, or in any other way, or by any other means that the organiser might deem appropriate, without the need to remunerate any participant in any way. Persons or organisations, as deemed appropriate by the competition organiser, may also exercise the above rights.

2.5 All competition performances are judged by a Jury. The Jury is composed of eminent musicians, artists and teachers. Jury decisions cannot go to appeal and are final.

2.6 All other matters, meritorious and organisational, falling outside the jury's remit, are subject to the Competition Director's decision, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

### 3. COMPETITION PRIZES

3.1 The first three winners in each instrumental section and category receive the title of laureate.

3.2 The following prizes to each will be awarded (diploma):

- for the best performance of a work by a Polish composer,
- for the best performance of a work by Fryderyk Chopin,
- for the best performance of the work by Juliusz Zarębski,
- for the best performance of the composer's work of origin of the participant.
- special prize "Personality of the Competition" of **250 EUR**.

3.3 The Jury reserve the right not to award prizes or to award them *ex aequo*.

3.4 All money and material prizes conferred by both institutions and private individuals, and awarded outside the competition's remit, must be reported to the Competition Secretariat.

3.5 Laureate diplomas and material prizes are only available for collection on the day of the Prizewinners Concert or will be sent to the address provided.

3.6 The winners and the awarded may be invited to take part in the Winners' Concert.

3.7 The teachers of the winners will receive commemorative Diplomas.

3.8 Distinguished Accompanionists hold commemorative Diplomas.

### 4. COMPETITION PROGRAMME

**Important:** A participant may take part in an older age category.

The competition programme for all instrumental sections and all age categories is free. There is a free choice of programme.

#### INSTRUMENTAL SECTIONS:

**SOLO PIANO , VIOLIN, CELLO, CHAMBER ENSEMBLE.**

**Pieces should be performed from memory with the exception of the Chamber Ensemble section.**

Only time limits apply:

**CATEGORY 'A'** (time up to 10 minutes)

Two contrasting pieces of music.

**CATEGORY 'B'** ( time up to 12 minutes)

Two or three contrasting pieces, with one of the Baroque or Classical periods.

**CATEGORY "C"** (time up to 15 min.):

Free programme.

**CATEGORY "D"** ( time up to 15 - 20 minutes).

Free programme with an obligatory performance of a virtuoso piece.

**CATEGORY "E"** (performing time up to 20-30 minutes).

Minirecital - free programme.

**CATEGORY "F"**. Performance time up to 30 minutes.

Recital - free programme.

### 5. CONDITIONS

5.1 The Competition is open to children and youth from Poland and abroad - students of music schools, academy, conservatory, students and university graduates, , educating both in public and non-public institutions as well as in private individual form.

5.2 A set of documents to be sent by the candidate (regardless of the section: piano solo, soloist, chamber ensemble) by **07 December 2022 Online form available on the Contest website [www.konkurs-zarebski.eu](http://www.konkurs-zarebski.eu) , which will include the following information about the Candidate:**

1) **Program** of the competition performance (including the duration of the performance);

2) **Video recording** of the competition performance submitted in accordance with the INSTRUCTIONS, which can be found at: [www.konkurs-zarebski.eu](http://www.konkurs-zarebski.eu);

3) Participants **photograph** (9 x 12 cm) electronic (JPG, TIF);

4) **Birth certificate** or any document confirming candidate's date of birth, (a photocopy or scan is acceptable).

6) the **RODO** and other information (date of birth, email address);

Incomplete Forms will not be considered.

**Please note that participants who are citizens of Ukraine are exempted from paying the "Brick for statutory purposes" fee. Participation in the Competition by Ukrainian citizens is free of charge.**

5.4 Incomplete documents will not be considered.

Fees are non-refundable where a candidate withdraws from the competition, however fees will be returned to candidates who do not qualify for entry.

5.6 The submission of an application is deemed to imply acceptance of the conditions as outlined in the regulations governing this competition.

5.7 Written opinions of the participant's performance may be prepared after the application to the Organiser (additional fee).
